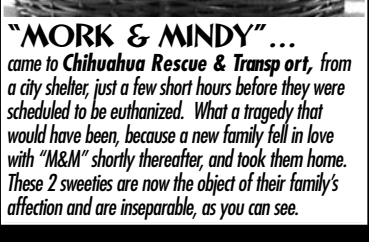
## "CASSIE" (w/her Sara)...

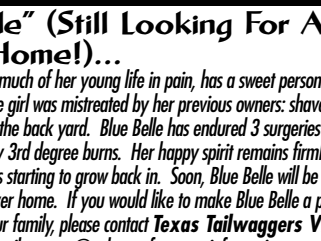
## "MORK & MINDY" ...
